UNLAWFUL DETAINER PACKET COVER SHEET

This packet contains the information and forms for filing an Unlawful Detainer case. Unlawful Detainer Packets may be purchased at the Clerk's Office if needed for \$2.55.

Please note the CLERK OF COURT cannot give legal advice to you or interpret the law for you. If you need legal advice, please contact an Attorney or Community Legal Services of Mid-Florida (CLSMF) at 1-800-405-1417.

UNLAWFUL DETAINER

(<u>not an</u> Eviction)

USE THIS PACKET IF:

- 1) You are trying to remove someone from your home; and
- 2) You have a legal right to reside in your home (you are the owner or are the legal tenant); and
- 3) The person you are trying to remove does **not** have a legal right to reside in your home (they are not an owner or the legal tenant); and
- 4) There is no agreement for rent (verbal or in writing) between you and the person you are trying to remove.

Example: You let a friend or relative live in your home. You have now told them to leave, and they refused.

If your situation does not meet these criteria, unlawful detainer may not be the appropriate action, and you should review the information on eviction and ejectment. CONTACT AN ATTORNEY with any questions. This does not constitute legal advice.

Unlawful Detainer is a county court lawsuit, filed pursuant to Florida Statute Chapter 82.04, to request that another person be ordered to leave your property. It is similar to an eviction proceeding except that in an Unlawful Detainer case, there is <u>no landlord/tenant relationship</u> between the parties, i.e. there is <u>no agreement to pay rent</u>, either verbal or in writing. If there is an agreement to pay rent, verbal or in writing, you should consider filing an eviction case. Consult with an attorney if you are not sure.

Retain copies of all forms filed for your own records.

FILING FEE: \$300.00 (payable to Clerk of Court by cash, check, money order, debit/credit card)

Summons issuance fee: \$10 per defendant (summons is already prepared and given to Clerk)

Summons prep and issuance fee: \$17.00 per defendant (clerk prepares and issues summons)

Clerk's Certificate of Mailing:* \$7.00 (plus two preaddressed stamped envelopes)

Oath Fee: \$3.50 (per signature (if document(s) is not notarized)

Sheriff's Service Fee \$40.00 per defendant

(Sheriff's fee is payable by cashier's check or money order/no personal

checks).

*IMPORTANT: If a Defendant cannot be found, the Sheriff is allowed to serve the summons and complaint by posting them on the premises. The Clerk can also mail the documents by first-class mail and issue a Certificate of Mailing in the court file if the Plaintiff provides the Clerk with additional copies of the complaint, one envelope (with two stamps) addressed to the defendant(s), and \$7.00 to prepare the Certificate at the time of filing.

It is important to remember that a delay can occur as a result of any errors on your paperwork, or if the proper fees are not submitted.

Directing the various types of causes of action to remove someone from your premises can be difficult and confusing. Information or forms provided by the Clerk of Circuit Court should be considered as basic information only and may not be applicable to every situation. The information is not intended to be used as legal advice. Specific guidance as to how to proceed with filing a lawsuit or answering a lawsuit and questions about your particular situation should be directed to a qualified attorney. If you do not know an attorney, you may call the Lawyer Referral Service at 1-800-342-8011. If you do not have the money to hire an attorney, you may apply to Community Legal Services by calling 1-800-405-1417.

FILING CHECKLIST

STEP 1 – File case with Clerk

To file an Unlawful Detainer case, you may file the following forms along with the filing fee and any service fees, if applicable, with the Clerk's office.

- Complaint for Unlawful Detainer
 - o (1) Original filed with the Clerk and (1) copy for each Defendant to be served
 - Sign the original in front of a notary OR the Clerk's office can put you under oath for a fee.
 - A copy of the deed, lease or other proof of Plaintiff's right of possession needs to be filed with this Complaint
- Statement of Responsibility
- Permission to Use Email form
- Consent to Case Closure after 90 Days
- Civil Cover Sheet

Take the <u>original</u> Complaint (with copies) and the Sheriff's fee to the County Clerk's office at the following address: Flagler County Clerk of Court, County Civil Division, Kim C. Hammond Justice Center, 1769 E. Moody Boulevard, Building No. 1, 2nd Floor, Bunnell, Florida 32110.

STEP 2 – Obtain Judgment

5 days after service on the Defendant(s):

and the Defendant(s) DID NOT respond, you may file the following forms:

- Motion for Clerk's Default
- Motion for Default Final Judgment
- Non-Military Affidavit (must be notarized OR the Clerk can put you under oath for a fee)
- Judgment for Possession (complete the heading only, names and case number)
 - o (1) Original and (1) copy for <u>each</u> Plaintiff AND Defendant and pre-addressed stamped envelope for each party as well
- If the Defendant did not file an answer and is in the military, STOP HERE and consult an attorney.

OR

The Defendant(s) DID respond:

- A hearing will be set by the Judge. You will be notified by mail or email (if your email address has been provided) when the hearing is scheduled.
- Judgment for Possession (complete the heading only, names and case number)

Bring the Judgment for Possession and (1) copy for <u>each</u> Plaintiff AND
 Defendant to the hearing and (1) pre-addressed stamped envelope for each party as well.

If the judge grants your complaint, the Judgment for Possession will be signed.

STEP 3 – Obtain Writ of Possession

If the Defendant(s) refuses to leave the property after the Final Judgment has been signed, you may request a Writ of Possession and have it issued by the Clerk, allowing the Sheriff's department to remove them from the property.

• The Clerk charges a fee of \$7 to prepare the Writ, payable by cash, check, money order or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Discover). The cost of the Sheriff to serve the writ is \$90, payable by cashier's check or money order, no personal checks will be accepted by the Sheriff.
